


A picture of your family

FOR A LONG TIME I ONLY WORE MY HAIR DOWN, NEVER IN A PONYTAIL, BECAUSE I DIDN'T WANT TO DRAW ATTENTION TO MY HEARING AIDS. AS I GOT OLDER AND GAINED CONFIDENCE, I STARTED TO REALIZE I SHOULD JUST BE ME AND WEAR MY HAIR HOWEVER I WANT. NOW I AM PROUD TO SHOW MY HEARING AIDS!


